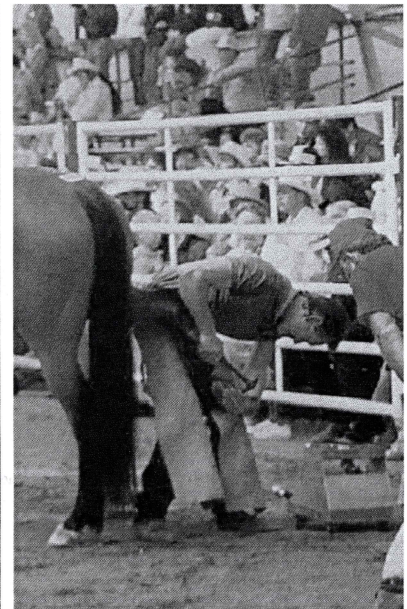
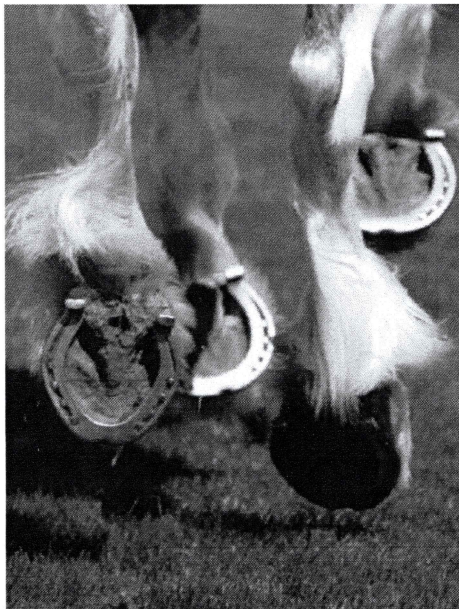

Shayne Carter, CJF, MB - Judge & Clinician

Shayne Carter of Draper, Utah, has traveled the world as an accomplished farrier, horseman, toolmaker, and bladesmith. In 1984, Shayne won the World Champion Blacksmith Competition (WCBC) at the Calgary Stampede at age 23. He was on the American Farriers Team in 1986, 1988, 1990, 1993, 1997, and 1998. In 1998, Shayne received the Jim Linzy Outstanding Clinician Award. In 2000, Shayne was voted "Farrier Industry Legend". This was awarded to the top 25 most influential contributors to the farrier industry. In 2003 Shayne was inducted into the International Horseshoeing Hall of Fame. Shayne passed his test to become a Master Bladesmith with the American Bladesmith Society. Shayne's knives have become well-known for their exceptional functionality and beautiful designs. He competed (twice!) in and won Forged in Fire in season three. Shayne travels all over the world teaching clinics on horseshoeing skills, blacksmithing, knife and tool making. - **Special Forging Clinic** - Shayne will prepare farriers for the particular demands and challenges of the contest. He will demo shoes and can assist farriers in forging.
- **Live Shoeing Saturday** - Original Closeburn, Scotland format - Each farrier/competitor, will be judged on one shod foot and one specimen shoe, with the assistance of a striker/fireman,
- **Awards Banquet and BBQ Blowout** – This feast, the competition, and the clinic, all benefit the EMP Scholarship Fund to assist the education of a student in a farriery school – a concept Edward wholeheartedly endorsed.
- **Competitors can bring their own forges** – coal, coke or propane. Or reserve a sideblast coke station from us

Forging Contests, with the help of striker,

Class A – 60 minutes to forge 2 shoes

- 1) Front Shire Bevel Draft shoe with toe clip from TBA, plain stamped
- 2) Front Draft Agricultural Shoe with toe clip from TBA, fullered with Agricultural heel caulks

Class B - 60 minutes 2 shoes

- 1) Hind Draft shoe with toe clip from TBA, toe clip, plain stamped, double caulks
- 2) Hind Draft Agriculture Shoe from TBA, toe clip, plain stamped medial branch with swelled heel, Fullered Lateral Branch with agriculture heel

Class C – 35 mins. Eagle Eye. TBA

Saturday March 23rd - Live Draft Shoeing, Clinic, 1 Forging Class, & Banquet/Auction

Contestant's meeting with judge Shayne Carter, will begin at 8AM Saturday. As in the Land of the Scots, each contestant, with the help of a striker/fireman, will **shoe one front foot**, a $\frac{3}{4}$ fullered toe clipped shoe built from $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " bar stock. Each farrier will also forge a **specimen shoe** – TBA. Contestants will be allotted 90 minutes for the competition. Contestants must provide their own horse handler, their own hand tools and their own nails. There will be 30-minute breaks between each heat. Side Blast coke forge work stations may be reserved. Contestant may also bring their own freestanding coke, coal or propane forge if they prefer. Coke available \$40 per sack.

First place winner's name goes on perpetual trophy and receives a trophy plaque. Ribbons and incentive prizes will be awarded to the top competitors along with 50% of Entry fees. All awards will be presented at the EMP BBQ to be held on-site one hour after the last round ends. Beer, wine and soft drinks will be available.
